A New Columbia River Treaty - Columbia Insight

In 1964, Canada and the United States (U.S.) ratified the Columbia River Treaty (Treaty), a transboundary water management agreement. The impetus for the Treaty was the disastrous flood of 1948 which devastated the City of Vanport in Oregon and cost many lives, along with growing power demand in the Pacific Northwest.

The Columbia River Treaty between the United States and Canada mandated the construction and operation of three water-storage dams in British Columbia (Canadian storage) for the purpose of providing flood control and optimum hydropower generation in the Columbia River Basin in Canada and/or the United States. The Treaty also authorized construction of Libby Dam on the Kootenai River in Montana for flood control and other purposes in the United States.
