Anandavardhana: Dhvanyaloka, Uddyota 1

Author of Dhvanyaloka, a treatise on the nature of aesthetic enjoyment in literature, Anandavardhana wrote in Sanskrit. He gave the most complete formulation of the theory of dhvani, which affirmed that the aesthetic essence of poetry consists not in the images themselves but in the associations and concepts they evoke.

Ānandavardhana (c. 820–890 CE) was the author of Dhvanyāloka, or A Light on Suggestion (dhvani), a work articulating the philosophy of "aesthetic suggestion" (dhvani, vyañjanā). The philosopher Abhinavagupta (c. 950 – 1016 CE) wrote an important commentary on it, the Locana, or The Eye.

Anandavardhana confined his attention to the poetic language and to the suggestion of meanings of aesthetic value. His theory of Dhvani, to put it simply, is Vyanjana or suggestion as applied to poetry. In the process, Anandavardhana chose to align his theory of Dhvani with Rasa as initially outlined by Bharata.
